Red Wines

2009 Robert Biale Zinfandel Varozza Vineyard Napa Valley \$49.99/\$42.99/\$38.69

Beautifully integrated, and a showcase for what Zin can be in the right hands—a complex wine full of blackberry and black cherry fruit, floral essences, coriander and white pepper spice. Full on the palate, this bursts with fruit and has a nice mineral edge to it, too. “Sleek and appealingly rustic, featuring black raspberry and toasty vanilla aromas and ripe, savory flavors of black cherry, smoky pepper and sage. Finishes with briary tannins. Drink now through 2017.” - *Wine Spectator*, 92 points. **New item.**

2009 Syncline Pinot Noir Columbia George \$32.99/\$27.99/\$25.19

“With a foundation based on the old vines from Celilo 51% (1972) and incorporating a newer planting at an adjacent vineyard on Underwood Mountain 49% (2001), this 100% Pinot Noir shows an opulent nose starting with ripe strawberry and cranberry aromas, mingling with fresh cracked black pepper and rose petals. The overall impression of juicy, red fruit is complemented by bright acidity. The wine is beautiful, with enough acid and silky tannins to really shine with three to five years bottle age. Here is a wine that proves great Pinot Noir can be grown in Washington. 300 cases produced.” - Winemaker notes. **New vintage.**

2006 Château Grand Barrail Lamarzelle Figeac Saint Emilion Grand Cru Bordeaux \$24.99/\$21.39/\$19.25

A classic blend of 65% Merlot and 35% Cabernet Franc. The wood blends with the bouquet of vanilla, dark berries and a touch of orange which continue on the palate. Silky tannins provide a pleasant finish. Exceptional soil thanks to the presence in the basement of a vein of blue clay. The average age of the vines is 40 years. Michel Rolland is the consultant. **New item.**

2008 Anne Amie Vineyards Pinot Noir Willamette Valley \$24.99/\$20.59/\$18.53

“Aromas of black cherry, raspberry, cedar and sage. Flavors of black cherry, horehound, chicory coffee and vanilla. The finish is long with smooth tannins. The ultimate food wine, this Pinot Noir is a brilliant match for any fare. From traditional Northwest cuisine, such as cedar-planked salmon or wild mushroom soup, to smoked or grilled meats... even just a great burger and truffle fries!” - Winery notes. **New vintage.**

2007 Cedergreen Cellars Thuja Red Columbia Valley \$30.14/\$22.69/\$20.42

“The aroma of this blend of 80% Merlot and 20% Cabernet Sauvignon entices the nose with notes of black cherries and berries, toast and bright jam. It has grip, depth, spice and cola. Thuja will benefit with decanting one to three hours prior to serving. 50% new French oak and 50% neutral oak. 220 cases produced.” - Winemaker notes. **New vintage.**

2008 Steele Cabernet Sauvignon Red Hills Lake County \$42.99/\$19.99/\$17.99

“This wine has a rich fruit-forward elegance. A spicy and herbaceous core backed up by soft tannins makes it a nice glass of wine for casual sipping among friends. It would also pair wonderfully with a spice-rubbed rib eye steak or rack of lamb.” - Winemaker notes. **Great Price! New item.**

2008 Cottonwood ‘Marina Piper’ Pinot Noir Willamette Valley \$21.99/\$14.99/\$13.49

Flavors of black cherry and blackberry, intermingled with baking spices and vanilla. The wine has a long finish and the finely grained, silky tannins and uplifting acidity balance the fruit well, making it a great food wine. Coming from such a great vintage, this is a great value; lots of delicious Pinot Noir for the price! **New vintage.**

2008 Pendulum Red Columbia Valley \$27.99/\$13.99/\$12.59

A blend of Merlot, Syrah, Cabernet Sauvignon, Barbera, Sangiovese, Cabernet Franc, Petite Verdot and Malbec, this comes predominantly from Alder Ridge, a windswept vineyard in the Horse Heaven Hills along the Columbia River. The dusty scents of dry barbecue rubs and five-spice powder evoke the dry heat of the place, but the flavors are saucy with mellow, red cherry fruit edged in smoky tannin. Great with grilled dry-aged beef. **New vintage.**

2009 Joel Gott 815 Cabernet Sauvignon California \$24.99/\$13.99/\$12.59

“Offers engaging and layered aromas of blackberry and dark plum with hints of spice, cedar and vanilla. The polished tannins and velvety texture lead to an elegant and long finish.” - Winemaker notes. **New vintage.**

2009 Duboeuf Morgon Jean Descombes Gamay Beaujolais France
\$17.99/\$13.49/\$12.14 “Light tannins and a smoky mineral note frame is lush red, which display layers of black cherry, raspberry ganache and tea rose flavors. There’s a spicy thread running through the wine, leading to a fresh firm finish.” - *Wine Spectator*, 93 points. **New vintage.**

2009 Mas de Boislauzon ‘La Chaussyne’ Vin de Table Rhône France \$13.99/\$11.19/\$10.07

The brother and sister team of Daniel and Christine Chaussy are the sixth generation to run the esteemed Mas de Boislauzon estate. La Chaussyne is essentially declassified Châteauneuf, made with a blend of Grenache, Syrah and Mourvèdre. A herald of what is to come from 2009! It has intense ripe berries, lavender, spice and garrigue notes with a big juicy finish. A mini-marvel at this price! **New vintage.**

2009 Antinori Santa Cristina Sangiovese Tuscany \$15.99/\$9.39/\$8.45

Antinori is Italy’s single best-known wine producer, and rightfully so, with over 600 years of history making fine wine. A blend of Sangiovese (85%), Merlot (10%) and Cabernet Sauvignon (5%). An intense bouquet of cherry and raspberry fruits, along with hints of violet and tobacco. Smooth and well-structured on the palate with delicious tannins and a persistent finish. **New vintage.**



2007 gaVin Pinot Noir Willamette Valley \$12.99/\$9.39/\$8.45

Aromas of raspberry and strawberry lead to flavors of red cherries, with hints of baking spices and supple tannins. This is a well crafted wine and considering the complexity and quality it is an incredible value in Willamette Valley Pinot Noir. **Enjoy! New item.**

2009 Etienne Beaujolais Villages France \$12.99/\$9.39/\$8.45

2009 in Burgundy/Beaujolais is an outstanding year. This is a ridiculously delicious wine and perfect for warm weather sipping. Just buy it and try it. You'll be back for more. "An especially fine value for the 2009 Beaujolais Villages from Paul Etienne." -Paul Gregutt, *The Seattle Times*. **New vintage.**

2004 Don Rodolfo Tannat Viña Conejo Argentina \$12.99/\$9.39/\$8.45

"Tannat is a rare French varietal that is assumed to have gotten its name from the heavy tannins in the wine, and thrives in South America. It's amazing that Don Rodolfo's young vines (six years old) produce such a full-bodied rich wine. At 6,000 feet above sea level, Don Rodolfo boasts being one of the highest altitude wineries in the world. This deep purple wine has heavy bright cherry and plum tones with a slight hint of honey and oak. The wine is dry with bright fruit that leads to a long acidic smokey finish." -Winery notes. **New item.**

White Wines

2009 Mark Ryan Chardonnay Columbia Valley \$29.99/\$25.99/\$23.39

"Polished and silky, this is generous, but not weighty, showing deep reserves of pear, quince and clove flavors, with hints of butterscotch as the finish retains its freshness and lingers well. Drink now through 2016. 300 cases made." - *Wine Spectator*, 91 points. **New vintage.**

2010 Sparkman Lumière Chardonnay Stillwater Creek Vineyard Columbia Valley \$29.99/\$23.39/\$21.05

"2010 brought richness and length to the delicate flavors from our cool site Chardonnay from Stillwater Creek Vineyard. A longer native fermentation in 2010 gave us layers of minerally pear and toffee on the nose. A rich creamy citrus midpalate finds its way to a vanilla laced finish. Production: 634 cases." -Winemaker notes. (Winemaker Chris Sparkman is GM at Waterfront Seafood Grill, Seattle.) **New vintage.**

2009 Wente Riva Ranch Arroyo Seco Monterey California \$21.99/\$14.99/\$13.49

"This medium-bodied Chardonnay has a rich, golden color and aromas and flavors of tropical fruit, honey, cinnamon and light floral notes, balanced by subtle oak, butter and vanilla from barrel aging. It has a round mouthfeel and a long, fruity finish." -Winery notes. **New vintage.**

2008 Dr. Hermann Riesling 'H' Mosel Germany \$16.99/\$13.99/\$12.59

The 2008 vintage in the Mosel region of Germany was fantastic, and this steal of a bottle from Rudi Hermann and his son, Christian, demonstrates those idyllic traits of this region that Riesling lovers adore. It's got gorgeous slate-like minerality, delicate, peachy, orchard fruit and herby aromas, and the kind of incredible freshness and balance that make Rieslings a great food wine. **New item.**

2010 Cellar Pardas Rupestris Emporda Penedes Catalonia Spain \$13.99/\$11.89/\$10.70

Pardas is a small, smart and intriguing new winery in the Emporda region which lies in the north-eastern corner of Catalonia. The region is also known as the Costa Brava. Rupestris is a crisp blend of the Catalan varietal Xarel-lo with a touch of Malvasia and Macabeo. It has great acidity with citrus notes and a creamy texture from aging four months on the lees. One of the highest rated Penedes wineries in the Guia Jose Penin, the top wine guide in Spain. **New item.**

2009 Cave de Lugny Mâcon Villages France \$12.99/\$9.39/\$8.45

This is a clean, crisp, blue chip value. The wine is done completely in stainless steel and then bottled. What the vineyard gives is what you get, in this case clean, bright flavors of mineral tinged citrus and aromas of fruit, white flowers and a hint of honey. **New item.**

2010 Domaine de Maubet Blanc Sec Côtes de Gascogne France \$10.99/\$8.39/\$7.55

A blend of Ugni Blanc, Colombard, Gros Manseng and Sauvignon grapes with flavors of citrus fruits and grapefruit, very fruity. Serve as an aperitif or with fish or seafood. Silver medal at the Concours Général Agricole. **New vintage.**

2010 Pierre Chaini Reserve Sauvignon Blanc Tour de Pocé Touraine Loire \$12.99/\$7.49/\$6.74

The superb 15th century Château de Pocé is set in magnificent grounds in the commune of Pocé-sur-Cisse on the north bank of the Loire. A refreshing Sauvignon Blanc with a fruity and floral nose, and aromas of grapefruit. The wine is very elegant and rich on the palate. **New item.**

Rosé Wine

2010 Cedergreen Cellars Viola Rosé Conner Lee and Good Earth Vineyards Columbia Valley \$14.99/\$13.09/\$11.78

"Our dry Rosé is a delicious treat of fresh, summer fruit. Perfect for a warm summer evening with a picnic hamper and a blanket spread on the grass. A concise mélange of strawberry, raspberry and light rhubarb notes tempered with minerality and graphite. 50% Cabernet Franc/50% Merlot. 100% stainless steel. 126 cases produced. Enjoy!" -Winemaker notes. **New vintage.**
